Our values and beliefs

What is bullying?

S.T.O.P Several Times On Purpose

Bullying is not an accident; a bully hurts someone on purpose.
A bully can hurt someone by:

- Physical: e.g. kicking, hitting and damaging their belongings.
- Verbal: e.g. name calling, threats and making offensive remarks.
- Indirect: e.g. spreading nasty stories about someone, gossiping and leaving someone out from social groups.
- Cyber: online messages, texts or making nasty phone calls or putting unkind videos on Youtube

If it is several times on purpose but to different people, this is still bullying.

What happens when someone is being bullied?

If you are being bullied or see bullying happening should tell your teacher or an adult straight away. We are a TELLING school.

- Tell someone if you are being bullied or have seen someone being bullied.
