Dear Parents and Carers,

The children are thoroughly enjoying learning about minibeasts, pond life and their life cycles. We have been given a fantastic opportunity to continue this learning and visit East Hanningfield Reservoir on Tuesday 5th June.

The children will arrive at school for 8:45am and will be picked up by you at 14:55pm. We will be taken by coach to East Hanningfield Reservoir where we will have a fun packed day doing a minibeast hunt and pond dipping.

On the day of this visit, your child will need to wear old clothes and footwear that can be used when getting muddy, wellies and a waterproof. You will also need to ensure that they wear a sun hat and have sun cream that will last the whole day, as we are unable to put sun cream on your children.

Children will need to bring their own packed lunch on the day. I will send a letter out closer to the time to give guidance on what to put in their lunch box.

For the visit to go ahead, we are asking for a donation of £6. This visit total cost is £712 but school will subsidise £400 through school fundraising and pupil premium money. This includes the cost of transport and the educational experience. If there are not sufficient donations, the visit will not take place. All donations and completed forms need to be returned to your child's class teacher.
