The children will also have the opportunity to have a hands-on curricular experience, creating their own Greek artefacts, making wax tablets, creating clay charms and experience what life was like in Ancient Greek time. They will take part in drama activities and role play to make it an immersive experience.

This day will be both exciting and rewarding for the children, as kick off our fascinating topic in style!
