Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our Topography topic in the Summer Term, we have organised an educational visit to Rayleigh Mount.

This will give the children a fantastic opportunity to see a local National Trust site and look around the grounds, as well as having the exciting opportunity to visit the windmill at the same time. All children will have a chance to discuss and observe the geography, take photos, and draw sketches which will help with their learning when we arrive back to school.

We will be going on Wednesday 25th April. The children will need to be dropped at Rayleigh Mount/Rayleigh Mill car park between 9.45am-10am and collected at 2pm. A member of Eastwood staff will meet you there and will be wearing an orange High Vis jacket.

The number 20 bus route stops at Kent Elms and the top of Bull Lane, leaving a very short walk across to the mount.

Children will need:

- to wear school uniform and sensible shoes for walking
- Waterproof jacket
- Packed lunch
- Water bottle
- Small backpack to carry their belongings in.

Those children entitled to a free school meal will be provided with a packed lunch if requested in the box below. If you do not tick the box, we will expect you to provide your children with a packed lunch.

In line with the school positive behaviour policy, if your child receives five card changes shortly before the trip, a risk assessment will be carried out by Mrs Perman and they may not be able to take part in the visit.
