Dear Parents and Carers,

Due to circumstances beyond our control, we will be **postponing** our Year 4 trip to Rayleigh Mount and Windmill **until Thursday 24th May 2018.**

Plans for the day will remain the same. Children will need to be dropped at Rayleigh Mount/Rayleigh Mill car park between 9.45am-10am and collected at 2.15pm. The number 20 bus route stops at Kent Elms and the top of Bull Lane, leaving a very short walk across to the mount.

This will give the children a fantastic opportunity to see a local National Trust site and look around the grounds, as well as having the exciting opportunity to visit the windmill at the same time. All children will have a chance to discuss and observe the geography, take photos, and draw sketches which will help with their learning when we arrive back to school.

Children will need:

- Waterproof jacket
- Packed lunch
- Water bottle
- Small backpack to carry their belongings in.

Those children entitled to a free school meal will be provided with a packed lunch if requested in the box below. If you do not tick the box we will expect you to provide your children with a packed lunch.
